### POSITIONS AVAILABLE UNDER THE 92<sup>ND</sup> GUILD LEADERSHIP

UNIVERSITY LEVEL		
<b>Guild President</b>	The executive head of the Guild and the leader of the Executive arm of the government.	1 for the entire university
COLLEGE LEVEL		
<b>CGC Chairperson</b>	Head the College Guild Council (CGC), which is the primary leadership organ of the Student's Guild at the college level.	1 per college
<b>Guild Representative Council (GRC)</b>	Forms the legislative body of the Students' Guild and provides representation of their schools or institutes.	2 per school/institute (1 female and 1 male)
<b>College Guild Council (CGC)</b>	Forms the primary leadership organ of the Students' Guild at the college level.	8 per college (atleast 4 females, the rest being male)
<b>Guild Tribunal</b>	Represents the college within the judiciary arm of the student government.	1 per college
<b>Debating Union Representative</b>	Represent the college within the Debating Union which is a student union organized to foster and manage debating activities within the University.	2 per college (1 female and 1 male)



<b>Games Union Representative</b>	Represent the college within the Games Union which is a specialized student organ that manages sporting and athletic activities.	5 per school (atleast 1 female, the rest being male)
<b>HALLS OF RESIDENCE LEVEL</b>		
<b>Hall Chairperson</b>	The top student leader of a specific hall of residence in-charge of leading the Students Common Room (SCR), which is the executive leadership organ at the hall level.	1 per hall
<b>Guild Representative Council (GRC)</b>	Students elected from within a hall to represent their residents in the central student parliament.	3 per hall (female halls) 2 per hall (male halls)
<b>Students Common Room (SCR)</b>	General Secretary: In-charge of the hall's executive meetings and record keeping.	1 per hall
	Secretary for Finance: Manages the hall-level budget.	1 per hall
	Secretary for Disciplinary: Responsible for maintaining high standards of conduct within the hall.	1 per hall
	Secretary for Health: Manages the cleanliness and welfare of the hall.	1 per hall
	Secretary for Sports and Entertainment: Responsible for the social and physical welfare of the hall residents.	1 per hall
	Secretary for Disabilities: Represents students with disabilities residing within the hall.	1 per hall



<b>EXTERNAL CAMPUS STUDENT GUILD COUNCIL</b>		
<b>External Campus Chairperson</b>	Chairs the External Campus Students Council (ECSC) and its Executive Committee, directing all student-led administrative activities on that campus.	1 person
<b>Guild Representative Council (GRC)</b>	Provides representation of the external campus within the Student's Guild.	2 people (1 female and 1 male)
<b>External Campus Executive Committee</b>	Serve as the primary administrative body at the external campus, managing day-to-day student affairs and implementing Guild policies.	5 people (atleast 2 females and 1 representative of Persons with Disabilities)
<b>STUDENTS' UNIONS</b>		
<b>Representatives Of Persons With Disabilities</b>	Offer representation of the students with disabilities within the Guild leadership.	4 people (2 females and 2 males, all representing different forms of disability)
<b>International Students Representatives</b>	Offer representation of the international students within the Guild leadership.	2 people (1 female and 1 male)
<b>Post Graduate Students Union Representatives</b>	Offer representation within the student's Guild with the responsibility of overseeing graduate student's matters.	2 per college (1 female and 1 male) 2 representatives of Persons with Disabilities (1 female and 1 male)
